THE FIRST MOBILITY OF THE PROJECT- IN ROMANIA

The **Secondary School No. 311** from Bucharest hosted the first mobility of the project, held from the 13th to the 17th of November 2023.

The mobility included workshops, study visits, round tables and meetings with parents, students, and teachers. It was an opportunity to officially start the project, to introduce the project and the partners, and to elaborate the project's work plan. During the activities, the partners presented good practices in their countries in working with children with special needs, especially in teaching and inclusion. On the 3rd day of the mobility, the participants assisted Romanian teachers in teaching and observe specific inclusive pedagogical strategies applied to students with special educational needs. A visit to a private inclusive school in Bucharest, ATLAS School, was organized for the guests. On days 4 and 5 of the mobility, the partners clarified the final results of the project and prepared by working in teams for the first draft of the training course provided by the project.

CULTURAL ACTIVITIES

In order to share cultural Romanian values, the beneficiary of the mobility participated in an extracurricular activity with special educational needs students, in the city of Brasov- Bran Castle, Peles Castle and also in Bucharest, visiting the Parliament Palace- the Romanian Senate.

Within 2 workshops, the Students Council and The Parent's Representative Council offered feedback on the nondiscrimination process and the inclusion activities in school.

ACTIVITIES IN CLASS

The visitors assisted to an interesting Geography lesson held in the SMART Lab of the school, a lesson of Physical Education with sixth graders and a Counseling activity in the classroom held by the tutor teacher of the eighth graders. Also, an innovative group counseling session with special needs and typical students was proposed by the school counselor and the support teacher. Music teacher, Social Science teacher and Primary School teachers were involved in a creative activity promoting inclusion in school through arts, music and theatre.
