We began our mobility at Fundación Docete Omnes (FDO), the hosting organization, in collaboration with Colegio Ave María Casa Madre. We started with a warm welcome to the teachers and students from Romania, Turkey, Greece, and Spain, introducing them to the activity program. During the morning, participants visited the Colegio Ave María Casa Madre and learned about Padre Manjón's educational philosophy, an inspiration for the local community. In the afternoon, the FDO team organized a guided tour of Granada, where they explored the city's rich history and impressive architecture. Participants also visited the FDO headquarters, where they had the opportunity to discover our facilities. There, we held a taracea workshop, a traditional wood inlay technique, guided by two experts in this art and shared with our users. It was a special moment of creativity and collaboration.
